Clean, then disinfect

Cleaning is when you use soap or detergent and water to remove dirt, germs and impurities. Disinfecting refers to the use of chemicals like bleach or alcohol to kill germs. Please ensure the cleaning involves both cleaning and disinfecting every area on the check list.



Use the right disinfectant

Diluted household bleach solutions, cleaning products with at least 70% alcohol and most common disinfectants registered by the Environmental Protection Agency are believed to be effective against the coronavirus.

Don't forget about sofas, rugs, drapes and other soft, porous surfaces.





Clean and disinfect laundry baskets and hampers.

Use a liner where possible, that is either disposable or machine washable. If not possible please sanitize thoroughly.

Empty the vacuum cleaner after every cleaning.

Disinfect the vacuum cleaner, along with other cleaning appliances like the dishwasher and washing machine.



Remember to check the expiration dates on your supplies.

——— Never mix household bleach with ammonia or other cleaning solutions-doing so can release toxic gases.
